(NAPA, California) The Napa County Board of Supervisors and Planning Commission Meetings have been relocated until further notice to 2741 Napa Valley Corporate Drive, Building 2 in Napa pending earthquake related repairs at the Napa County Administration Building.

Directions and Parking Information

From Downtown Napa

Take Soscol Avenue toward American Canyon and past Napa Valley College to Kaiser Road (you will see the Subway restaurant on the corner). Turn right onto Kaiser Road. Take the first left turn onto Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Continue on Napa Valley Corporate Drive for 0.4 miles to 2741-2751 Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Parking is in the back.

From American Canyon

Take State Highway 29 north toward the City of Napa. Take the Downtown Napa exit (Soscol Avenue). At the first traffic signal turn left onto Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Drive a short distance to Napa Valley Corporate Drive, cross over Napa Valley Corporate Drive and into the driveway of the South County Campus, 2741-2751 Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Drive to the back for parking.

From Calistoga/St. Helena/Yountville

Take Highway 29 South toward the City of Napa. Take the Imola Avenue exit and turn left at the signal. Continue on Imola Avenue for approximately 1.5 miles. Take the right turn ramp onto Soscol Avenue toward Napa Valley College. Drive past the College until you come to Kaiser Road (you will see the Subway restaurant on the corner). Turn right on Kaiser Road. Take the first left turn onto Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Continue on Napa Valley Corporate Drive for 0.4 miles to 2741-2751 Napa Valley Corporate Drive. Parking is in the back.
